NOTICE OF HEARING

This petition shall be served by the petitioner on any living non-petitioning parent or guardian (except a parent whose parental rights have been terminated by a court order) of the child whose name is proposed to be change, **no less than 10 days prior to the hearing.** Service shall be personal or by first class mail.

Anyone wishing to object to the name change must attend the hearing at the date and time given on the first page of the petition. The hearing will be held in Lac Courte Oreilles Tribal Court, located in the Lac Courte Oreilles Tribal Government Building on the Lac Courte Oreilles Reservation, at 13394W Trepania Road, Hayward, Wisconsin.
